Instructional Services

The library offers guided tours, as well as various database and research training courses related to your subject.

The library bought a corporate license for the software "Citavi" to create personal bibliographic databases. With our license, all members of the university can use the program free of charge.

University and State Library *Short essentials*

The University and State Library offers a large variety of services.

At our location Campus you'll find scientific literature with a focus on the subject groups taught at the university.

At the location Heinrich-von-Bibra-Platz there is the state and public library with many publications from or about Fulda, valuable historic manuscripts, large collections of fiction and popular science literature and the children and young adult department.

Library card

All university members and residents of Hessen and districts bordering on Fulda may apply for a free library card. You can find more information on our website or ask the staff at the front desk.

Facilities

In addition to books, there are newspapers, journals, CDs, audio-books, DVDs, sheet music, CD-ROMs and games available. The library also offers a large number of online-services.

also serving as printers for our public computers

scanners

where you can save text on a flash drive or send it via e-mail

group study rooms

at the location Campus for all groups of 3 or more people for joint work

for all members of the university.

Research and Lending

Our search portal FILIP records all items available at the library. You can

- search by topic or title to find out the specific location (book number) of a book or other item
- order books from the closed stacks
- place a reservation on borrowed items
- access your account (borrowed items, reservations, fees) and renew the loan period.

Most of our collection can be borrowed. The loan period usually is four weeks and can be renewed three times (exception: another user has placed a reservation).

If items are not returned in time, there will be overdue fines.

Electronic services

Databases

In our databases you can research for scientific information, which cannot be found in library catalogues or the internet. For more information check our website.

E-Books

The library also owns a large collection of electronic scientific literature. These books can be found in FILIP and can be accessed via the university network.

E-Journals

A lot of our scientific journals can be accessed online. You can search for the journals in FILIP and download the articles.

Onleihe

The Onleihe is a special system that allows you to search for digital media (e.g. novels, music and movies) and check them out by downloading them for a certain time.

FulDok

FulDok is a free-of-charge service for all members of the university. There you may publish scientific papers online via open access.

FulDig

On the „Fulda digitalization server“ you can find old books and manuscripts which have been scanned in to be studied online.
